Our College Has adopted the practice of Group Discussion to enhance and deepen the learning of the students. GD is conducted under the supervision of the teacher and it covers most of the topic of the curriculum. Virtual classes are conducted in the college covering various topic of the curriculum. Department enhance the understanding and learning of the students of the curriculum through educational tours and fields visit/survey. Teacher makes charts and posters to simplify the complex topic for the benefit of the students. After delivering each lecture, the teacher asks the students some short questions about the topics ensure that they have fully comprehended the subject material.
